Misconception of TB Clearance

You only need to submit your TB update the month it is due

Constantly revolving clearance depending on when you start at the facility or completed a particular immunization form

Several facilities require TB clearance valid of 9+ month or 3+ month

Know when your last TB or IGRA, T spot, Chest X-ray on file is so you will be prepared if you have to submit a more recent one

2-Step TB generally will require 4 visits

- 1st Visit: Receive first test placement
- 2nd Visit: Reading of first placement within 48 – 72 hours
- 3rd Visit: Placement 1 – 3 weeks following the first placement
- 4th Visit: Reading of second placement within 48 -72 hours

All forms require the dates for each visit

JABSOM HOME Clinic

Fall – Influenza Clinic

Spring – TB Clinic

Please note HOME clinic does not immediately send us your documents

Best to always make sure you have your own copy of the immunization

Immunization by Private Insurance

For the yearly influenza most insurances you may go to any pharmacy to have it administered

For Kaiser & Tricare you may need to make an appointment or see if their RX plan will allow for you to have an immunization at any pharmacy

CVS, Time's Supermarket, Safeway, Walmart, Costco, Sam's Club

X-Ray, IGRA or T-spot, Serology

Will always need an order from an APRN, PAs or MD

Will need appointment with your PCP, UH health services, CVS minute clinic, or urgent care clinic based on your insurance coverage

Insurances may not cover

Documentation Tips

BE PREPARED

Recommend to take photos, scan your immunizations – send them to the cloud, forward them to your PCP, access via your Mychart or online EHR portal for your records

For serology lab results make your own account to access your results for DLS or Clinical Labs

BE DETAILED

For one step TB updates please make sure you have the placed date, read date and mm in duration on the documentation

Facility immunization forms will require all these details

Need your full name and DOB on all documentation

AAMC Immunization Form Submission process

1. Complete the top portion of the form
2. Submit immunization/serology updates
3. Quantitative HepBsAb serology is required > 10 mIU/ml
4. Skin test or IGRA should not expire during proposed elective rotation dates or must be updated with institution prior to rotation
5. Processing time is 7 – 10 business days after submission

MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) – 2 doses of MMR vaccine or two (2) doses of Measles, two (2) doses of Mumps and (1) dose of Rubella; or serologic proof of immunity for Measles, Mumps and/or Rubella. Choose only one option.
Note: a 3rd dose of MMR vaccine may be advised during regional outbreaks of measles or mumps if original MMR vaccination was received in childhood.

More specifically what is required

- Feb - April is when submission for the away rotations begins
- Current TB/IGRA, Tspot or TB Screening forms and Quantitative HepBsAb serology
- Meningococcal has to be within 5 years, East Coast States this require this vaccination
- You may submit any additional immunization form requests for signature
- Other states and facilities may have additional vaccine requirements

Tuberculosis Screening History

School Purposes: a 2-Step TB within a year timeframe is acceptable

Two-Step is 2, one-step TB tests done 7 to 21 days apart

IGRA or T-Spot will also fulfill the TB requirement

Chest X-ray is only required if you are having symptoms or are TB Positive

State of Hawaii TB Questionnaire will need to be completed for AAMC (only if TB Positive)

Hepatitis B Vaccination

Best practice is to always complete the 3-shot vaccination series

After taking HepB vaccination, will need titers to be above 10 mIU/mL

If below, could either retake 3-shot series or 2-shot HepB Vaccine (ie Heplisav-B)

If your 2nd series of HepB titers is still under 10 mIU/mL, will need to take the Hepatitis B surface Antigen & Core Antibody labs

- Your records will be reviewed and processed
- Processing time is 7-10 business days after submission of required documents
